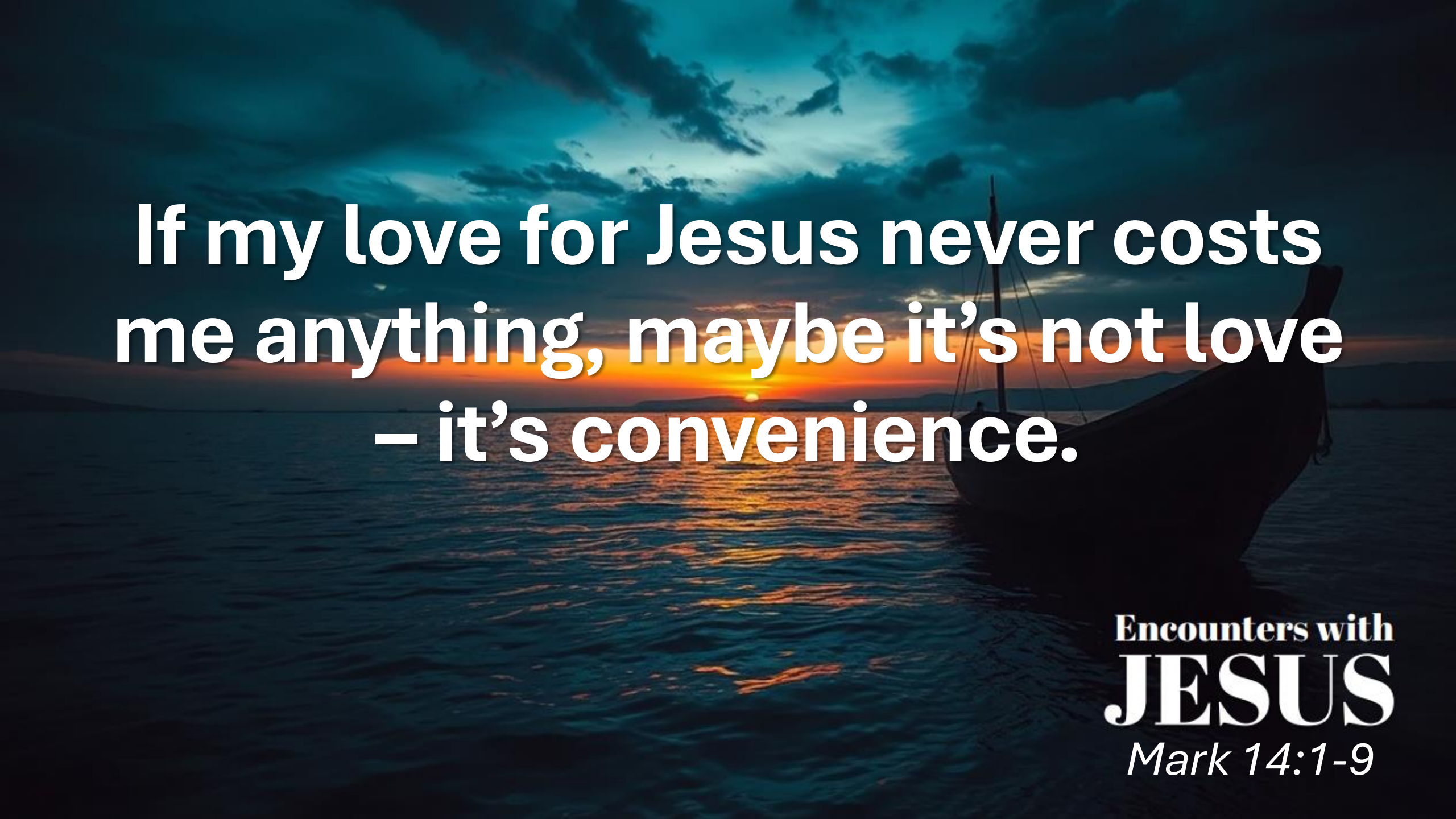
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1. **Love that costs is love that counts.** *“She broke the box and poured it on his head”* (vs. 3).
