- Arriving at the emergency scene:
 - 1. Identify/assess the need
 - 2. Stabilize the situation
 - 3. Get to more qualified help



 See hurting people (vs. 1-5).
 Sense real problems (vs. 6-11).
 Seize ministry opportunities (vs. 12-26).

- 1. The gift of healing was given during this transition time from the Old Testament law to the New Testament covenant of grace to prove the <u>authenticity</u> of the prophet and his message.
- 2. As the New Testament was finalized in written form, this miraculous <u>authentication</u> was no longer necessary – we can determine who speaks for God by comparing their teaching with Scripture.
- 3. Jesus and the apostles' healing gift dealt with blindness, deafness, paralysis, leprosy, etc.
- 4. The early church was not a miracle-working church, but a church with miracle working apostles.

Peter's Challenge

1. He talks about Christ (vs. 12-18).

2. He talks about repentance and what happens when we repent (vs. 19-26).
God will forgive your sin (vs. 19).
Judgment will be avoided (vs. 22-24).
Blessing will be realized (vs. 25-26).
