






Lessons about spiritual gifts:

1. Every Christian has been given one or more spiritual gifts to be exercised in the local church (the body of Christ) for the spiritual growth and health of the body (members).

Teaching Lessons

1 Corinthians 13:8-13

- 1. Supernatural (miraculous) gifts are temporary. (v.8)
- 2. Supernatural (miraculous) gifts are elementary. (v.11)
- 3. Supernatural (miraculous) gifts ended (fulfilled their purpose) at the completion of the New Testament canon (v.9-11)
 - a) The revelatory gifts provided partial knowledge and revelation (v.9)
 - b) These supernatural gifts AUTHENTICATED THE NEW REVELATION


