# When we pray ...

1. Do not be hypocritical (*vs. 5*).
2. Do not seek to be seen while praying (*vs. 6*).
3. Do not use meaningless repetition (*vs. 7*).

Don't pray *CRAZY*  
Don't pray *LAZY*  
Don't pray *HAZY*





*What should we do instead?*

1. Find a private place to be alone *(vs. 6)*.
2. Pray to your heavenly Father in secret *(vs. 6)*.

- 1. Express your dedication to God**  
*(vv. 9-10).*
- 2. Express your dependence on God**  
*(vv. 11-13).*
  - a. I need You to meet my physical needs**  
*(vs. 11).*
  - b. I need You to meet my spiritual needs**  
*(vv. 12-13).*



*Lord, I need you!*



*(9) "Our Father, which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name."*

*(10) "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven."*

*(11 - 13)*

**Father God, I dedicate myself to You today - help me to glorify You, to preserve Your holy reputation as I represent You in everything that I do.**

**I devote myself to serving You and doing Your will with everything that I have,**

**and Lord, I understand that I am totally dependent on Your grace if I am to do this.**
