

- Bishop overseers or administrators


dea·con /'dēkən/

noun

- 1. Servant or to serve
- 2. a man who meets the Scriptural qualifications (1 Tim. 3:8-13), and is chosen by the congregation to serve and care for the needs of the church body.

Two specific purposes of deacons:

- 1.To liberate the congregation to focus on ministry.
 - a) care for the needs of the individuals
 - b) care for the function of the organization
