There are 3 times in your life when the doctrine of God's OMNIPRESENCE is going to be incredibly important for you:

- When you feel isolated
- When you are overcome by anxiety
- When you are running from God



Truth:

Running from God doesn't get you away from Him, it gets you closer to His mercy.

Stop Running. Turn around. He's right there. Always has been.



Truth:
**Don't let darkness lie to you. You are not
alone; you are *SEEN*.**



Part 1 - Known. How well does God know me?

- God knows me completely (vv. 1-6).

Part 2 - Seen. How close is God to me?

- God is always with me (vv. 7-12).

Part 3 - Designed. How has God made me?

- God made me with a purpose (vv. 13-18).

Part 4 - Loved. Will God be there to help me?

- God wants to transform my heart (vv. 19-24).
