1. We have a compassionate God.

But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering and abounding in love and faithfulness.

Psalm 86:15

1. We have a compassionate God.

2. Jesus was full of compassion.

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

2. Jesus was full of compassion.

3. As worshippers of God and followers of Jesus, we are called to be people of compassion.

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, [compassion] kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering.
