Why did John call Jesus “*the Word*”?

1. ***A word*** is how we express what's inside us.
 - Jesus is God expressing Himself.
2. **Logos (*Greek*)** – reason, meaning, the principle that holds the universe together
 - You are not going to find that in an idea; it's a person!
