Part 1 - Known. How well does God know me?

- God knows me completely (vv. 1-6).

Part 2 - Seen. How close is God to me?

- God is always with me (vv. 7-12).

Part 3 - Designed. How has God made me?

- God made me with a purpose (vv. 13-18).

Part 4 - Loved. Will God be there to help me?

- God wants to transform my heart (vv. 19-24).

- **ESV “you formed my inward parts”**
- **Literal translation: “For you alone and no other have created my kidneys”**

**You are not the product of
chance. You are the masterpiece
of a personal God!**



The truth that changes everything:

“You don’t discover your identity by looking inside yourself... you discover it by looking to the One who made you.”



IDENTITY becomes secure when we
move from *self-focus* to *God-focus*.

Take Home Truths

- If you've been chasing identity in all the wrong places – *stop.*
- If you've believed the lie that you can't be loved as you have been created – *replace it with truth.*
- If you've wondered what your purpose is – *ask the one who created you.*
