Relationships Matter!

Take a deep look at the people in your life, because God is going to use these relationships as a key teaching tool in the shaping & molding of your character. **1. Relationships to Authority** COMMITMENT #1: I will honor Godgiven authority figures in my life and walk in humility before them. 2. Relationships with Regular People COMMITMENT #2: I will seek to be a man/woman of <u>character</u> and not be <u>distracted</u> by what others may think. **3. Relationships of Conflict** COMMITMENT #3: I will learn from personality <u>conflicts</u> in my life and seek to please God in my <u>responses</u>.

4. Relationships with Genuine Friends

One of the greatest resources you will have in your life is the resource of godly, genuine, faithful, true friends.


"Two are better than one... For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up."


