Ruth one of the sweetest ladies on earth

- 1. She was a woman of initiative.
- 2. She was a diligent worker.
- 3. She was characterized by humility.
- 4. She was others focused.

Principle #1

There are no coincidences in life. Our sovereign and purposeful God superintends in every detail of our lives.

There is a sovereign God in heaven whose hand is upon us every moment of the day, a God who reigns over every inch of the universe in which we live! (*Mt. 10:29; Pr. 16:9*)

Principle #1

Principle #2

4 characteristics of the kind of people who will be perfectly prepared for the mate God brings to them:

 They were patient with God's plan and content to be faithful to the responsibilities and circumstances God had placed them in.
They were not consumed with self-focused thoughts of love and marriage. The less concerned we are about our own needs, and the more committed we are to serving others, the more we allow God to arrange events and circumstances for our ultimate good. 4 characteristics of the kind of people who will be perfectly prepared for the mate God brings to them:

- 1. They were patient with God's plan and content to be faithful to the responsibilities and circumstances God had placed them in.
- 2. They were not consumed with self-focused thoughts of love and marriage.
- 3. They were open and transparent communicators.
- 4. They allowed God to use the circumstances of their lives to shape their character.

Takeaways:

- **1.** There are no coincidences in life You can trust HIM!
- 2. If you are not married, make a commitment to being in the place where God has put you, becoming the person God wants you to be, and going about life with an "others focus" - *You can trust HIM*!
- 3. If you are married ... God is the one who brought you together. This is the one that God has fashioned and shaped as the perfect fit for you. You have been made for each other by God *You can trust HIM!*
