2 Kings 6 Lessons

(What do I learn about God from this passage?)

2. God desires to evidence His power in the major issues of His people (vv. 8-23).



Three things to remember when you are facing insurmountable enemies

1. Don't be afraid – God is greater than every obstacle & enemy you face.
