Treating God's Name Carelessly

# Gake in vain?

- To use God's name in a careless or flippant manner
- Vanity "nothingness" or "trivial"
- To take God's name in vain means that it has been treated lightly or not taken seriously

#### **Commitment #1**

I will not misuse God's name with my lips. God's name is important to Him!

"minced oaths" an oath altered to milder or less obvious form "Oath" the irreverent or profane use of the name of God or of a sacred thing to express anger or emphasize a statement; a swear word or curse

#### **Commitment #2**

# I will not condone the misuse of God's name in my presence.

### Commitment #3

I will not misrepresent God's name with my life. Your character affects God's credibility.

#### God's name is a powerful tool.

#### **1.** It is a tool for VICTORY.

• David said as he approached Goliath, "You come against me with sword and spear, but I come against you in the name of the LORD Almighty." (1 Samuel 17:45)

#### 2. God's name is tool for HEALING.

- As Peter approached the temple, he saw a beggar sitting there. Peter said, "Silver and gold have I none, but such as I have I give you. In the name of Jesus, rise up and walk." (Acts 3:6)
- **3.** God's name is a tool of SALVATION.
  - I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. (1 John 5:13)
