Two notes:

Four Characteristics of DOUBT

- 1) Doubt is founded on the normal - limits God to what is “normal.”**
- 2) Doubt is often disguised as reason.**
- 3) Doubt fails to consider what God has already proven in the past.**
- 4) Doubt robs us of partaking in God’s full blessings for our lives.**
