Can I REALLY Change? The Need for Change

Romans 6:1-14

Romans 6 – Two Key Phrases 1) "we are dead to sin" (vs. 2) 2) "we should walk in newness of life" (vs. 4)

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- 1. There are no excuses for sin in the life of a believer "we are dead to sin" (vs. 2).
- 2. When a person receives Christ, they are committing themselves to a radically new kind of life "we should walk in newness of life" (vs. 4).

For the believer ... change is not an option!

- 3. Serving (Rom 12:10-11; 1 Peter 4:10)
- 4. Giving (Mt 6:21; 2 Cor 9:7; Luke 6:38)
- **5. Sharing your Faith (Acts 1:8; Matt 28:19-20)**

How does this change process take place?

Wrong Answer #1 "Read your Bible, pray every day, and you'll grow, grow, grow"

Wrong Answer #2

"Let go and let God"

Wrong Answer #3 *"ZAP theology"*

Wrong Answer #4

"Follow the list"

"newness of life" to make new, renovate

Key concept >> Spiritual Renovation <u>Renovation</u> is not the same as <u>remodeling</u>.

Proverbs 28:13

He that covers his sins will not prosper: but he that confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.



- 1. Confesses: Spiritual renovation involves <u>authentic confession</u>.
- 2. Forsakes: Spiritual renovation involves <u>radical</u> <u>amputation</u> (*Eph 4:22-24; Mt. 5:27-30*)

Ephesians 4:22-24

That you put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that you put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

There will be future temptations to repeat past acts of sin.

We must be prepared to meet and defeat these temptations when they come.
Nothing may be spared in the process –

it is radical amputation.

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
