6. **Love is NOT RUDE** *"does not behave itself unseemly"*
7. **Love is NOT SELFISH** *"seeks not her own"*

Love is NOT Irritable

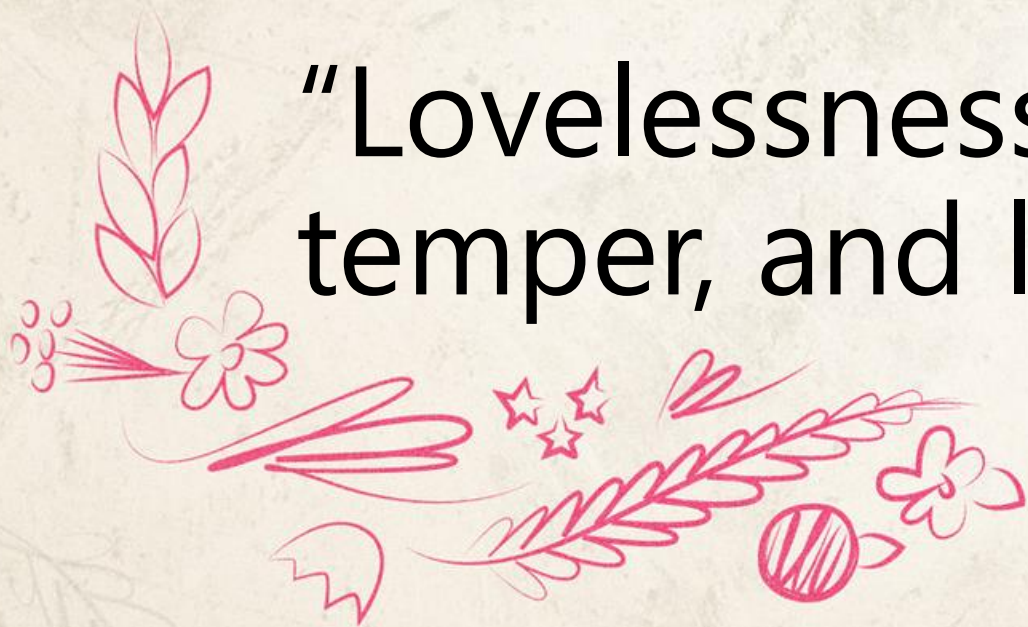

Love is NOT Vindictive

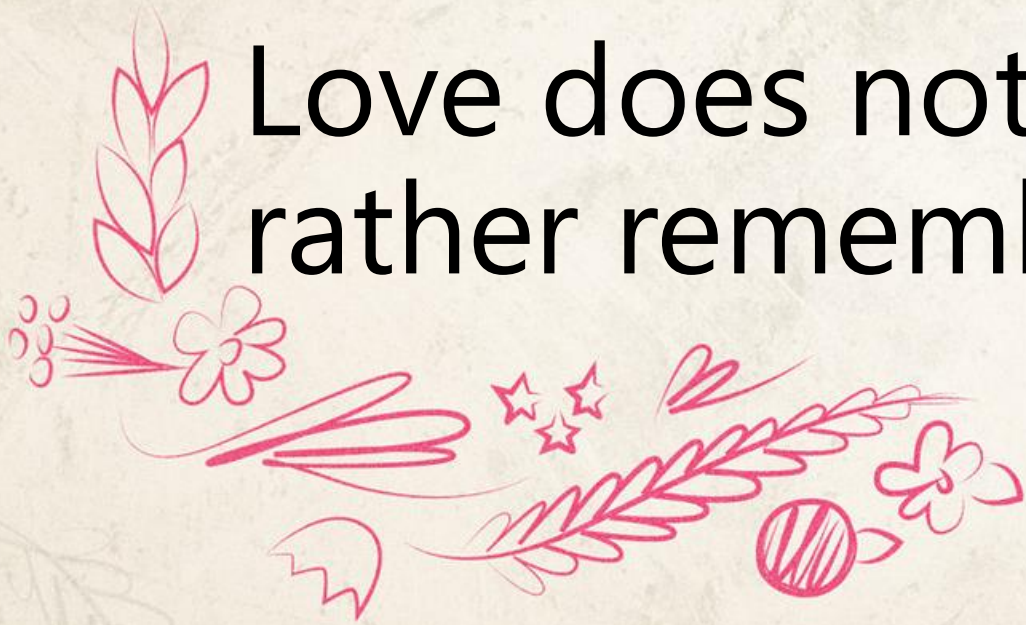
1 Corinthians 13:5
