1. more than just friendship; hanging out
2. *koinonia* – root idea is “common” or commonality
3. Carries the idea of partnership or “sharing”

At the heart of genuine fellowship
was a spirit of giving.

Fellowship cost something in
the early church.

2. We are to be committed to FELLOWSHIP

- 1) They gave of their things (v. 45).**
- 2) They gave of their time (vv. 42, 46).**
- 3) They gave of their homes (v. 46).**

This kind of fellowship resulted in:

1. Unity – This was a unified church. *“one accord; singleness of heart”* (v. 46)
2. Joy – This was a joyful church. *“fellowshipped together with gladness and singleness of heart.”* (v. 46)
3. Good favor – This was an attractive church. *“having favor with all the people”* (v. 46)
