J. I. PACKER When we have a personal relationship with God...


1. We long to commune with Him (vv. 9-11).

"and the Lord spoke unto Moses face to face, as a man speaks unto his friend" (vs. 11)



Commune:

To get very close to someone by exchanging feelings or thoughts



You will never experience a personal relationship with God [like friends] without the time spent in personal, tender communion together.

When we have a personal relationship with God...

- 1. We long to commune with Him (vv. 9-11).
- 2. We long for His direction, presence and power in our lives (vv. 12-23).


When we are friends with God, the things we want changed:


