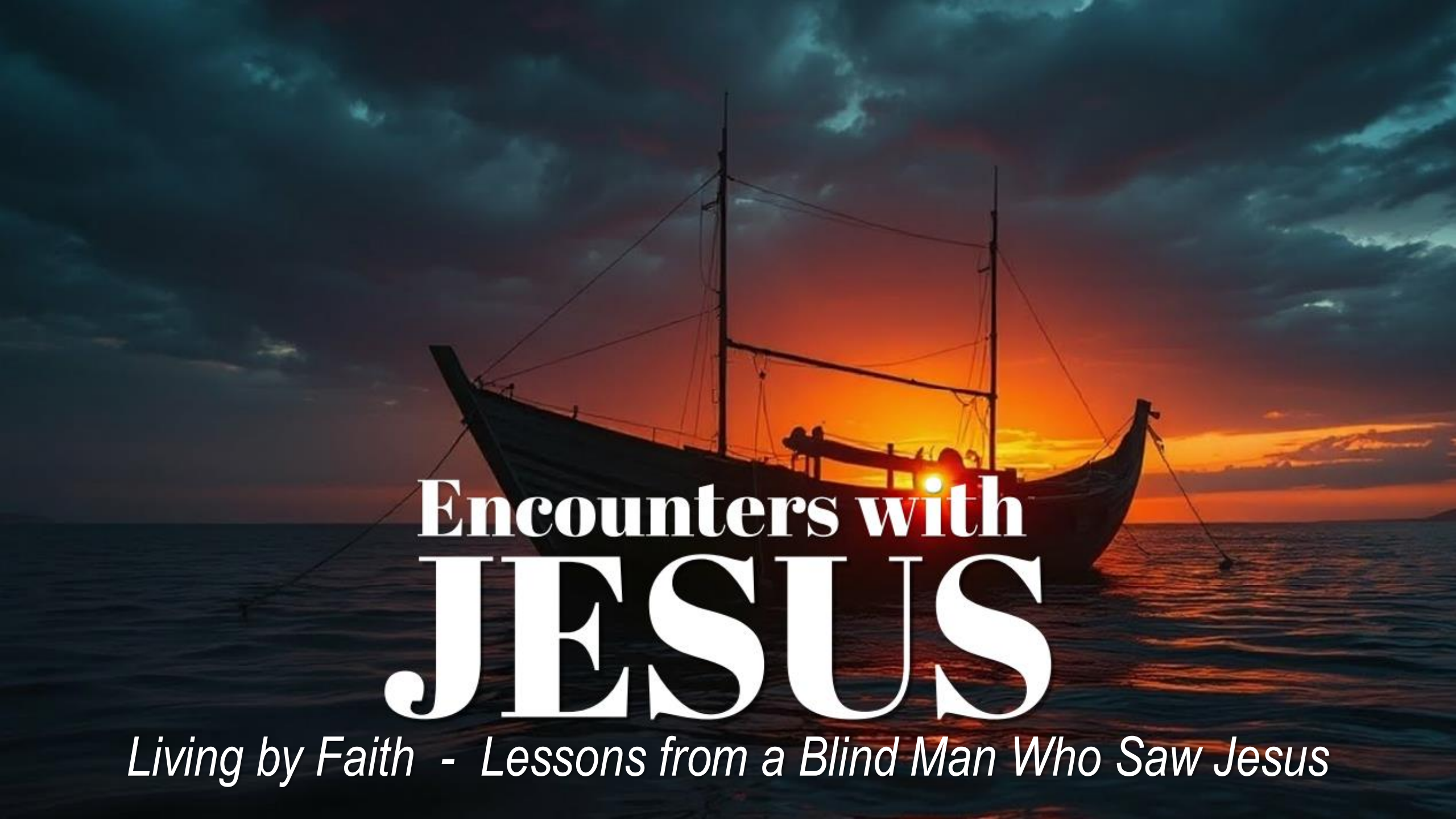
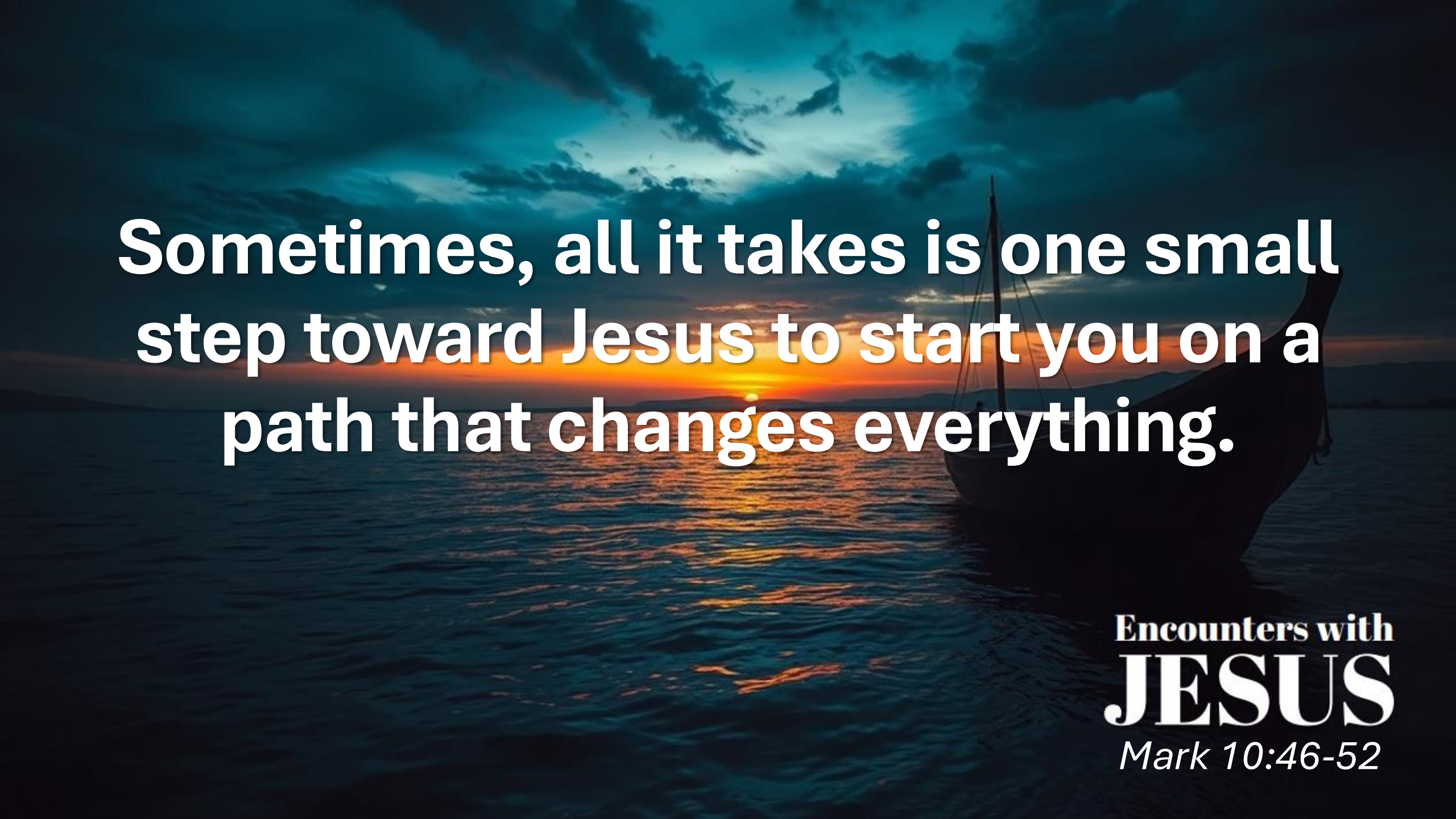

Living by Faith - Lessons from a Blind Man Who Saw Jesus

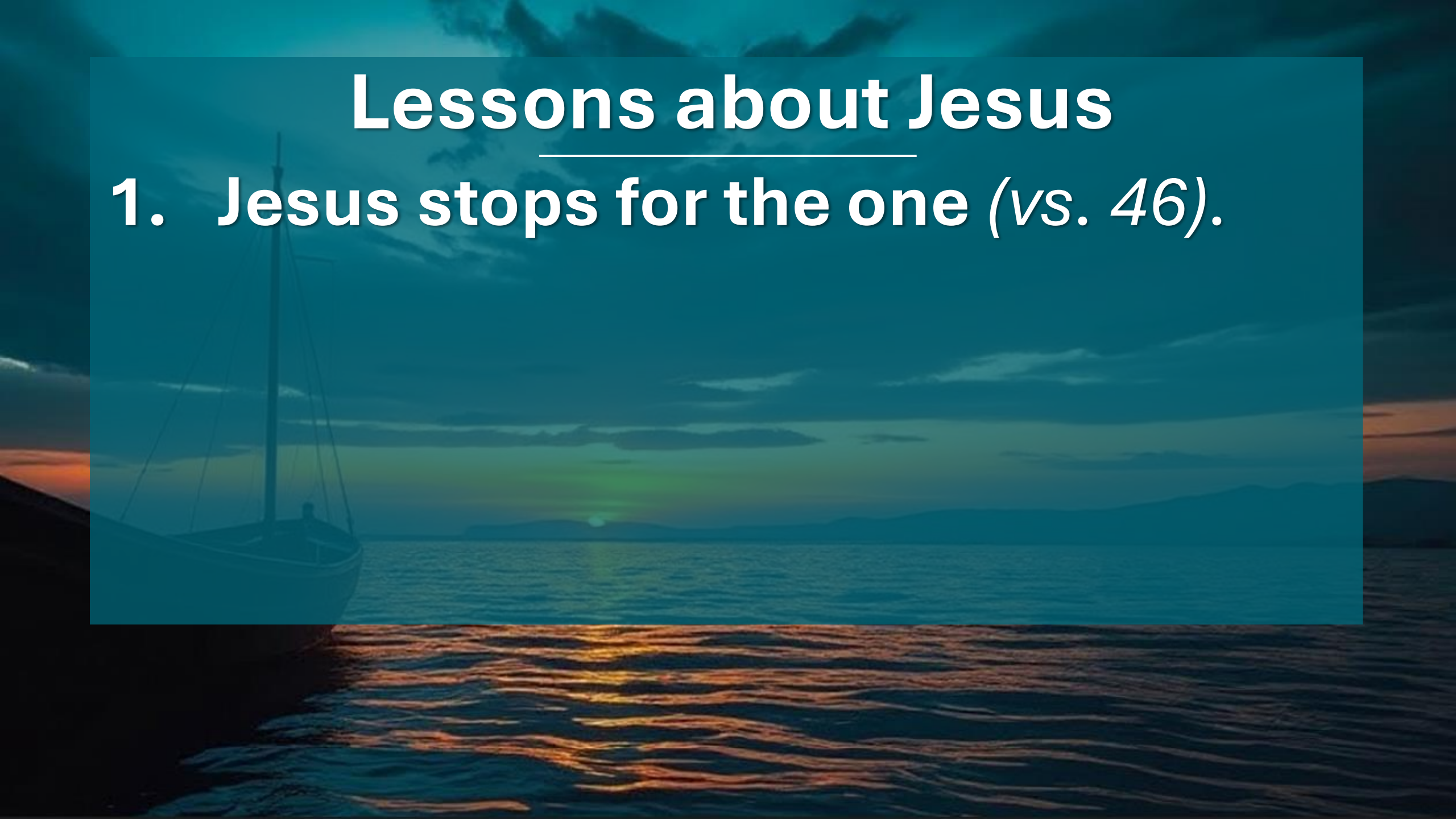

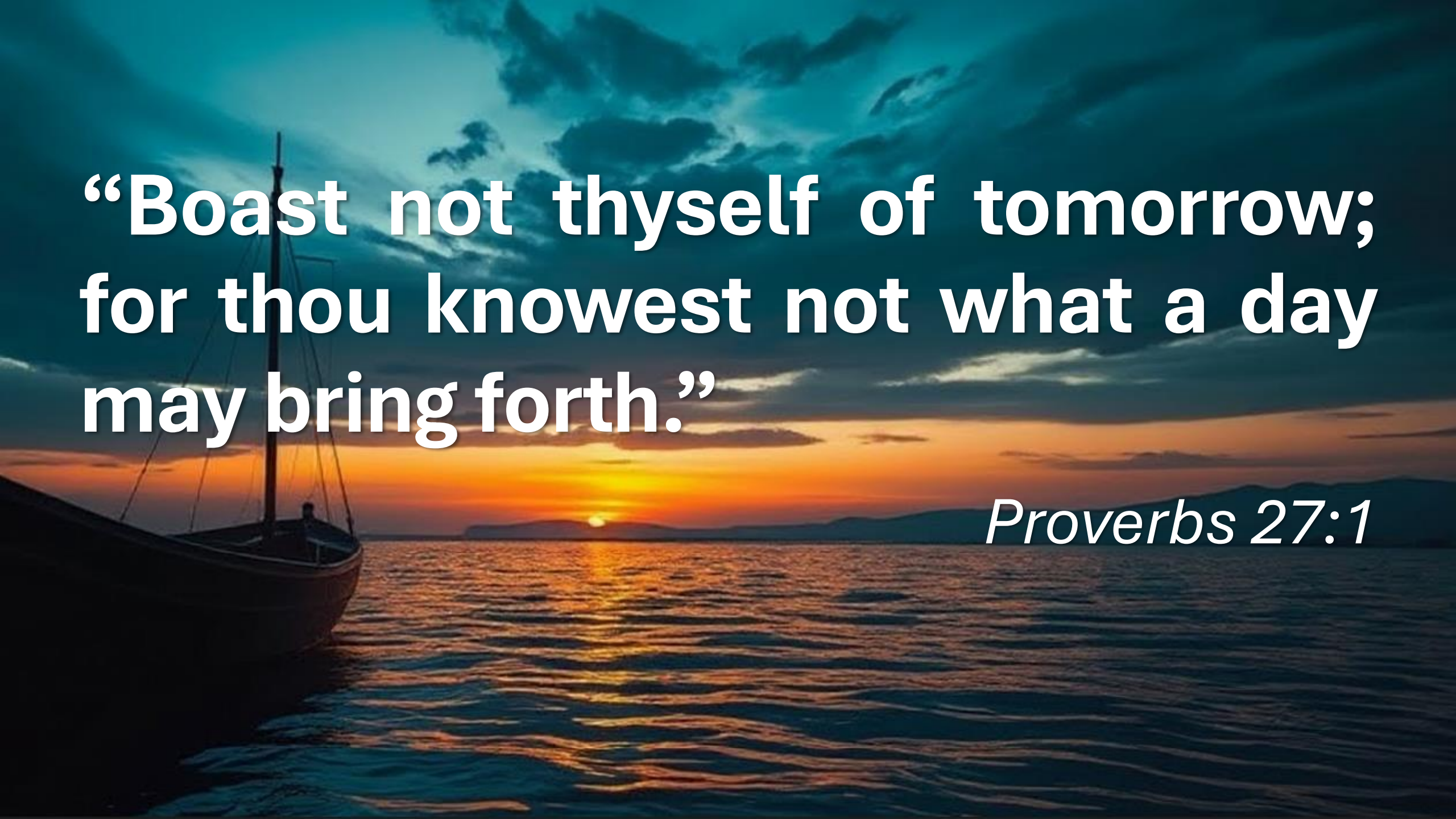
Lessons about Jesus

Lessons about Faith

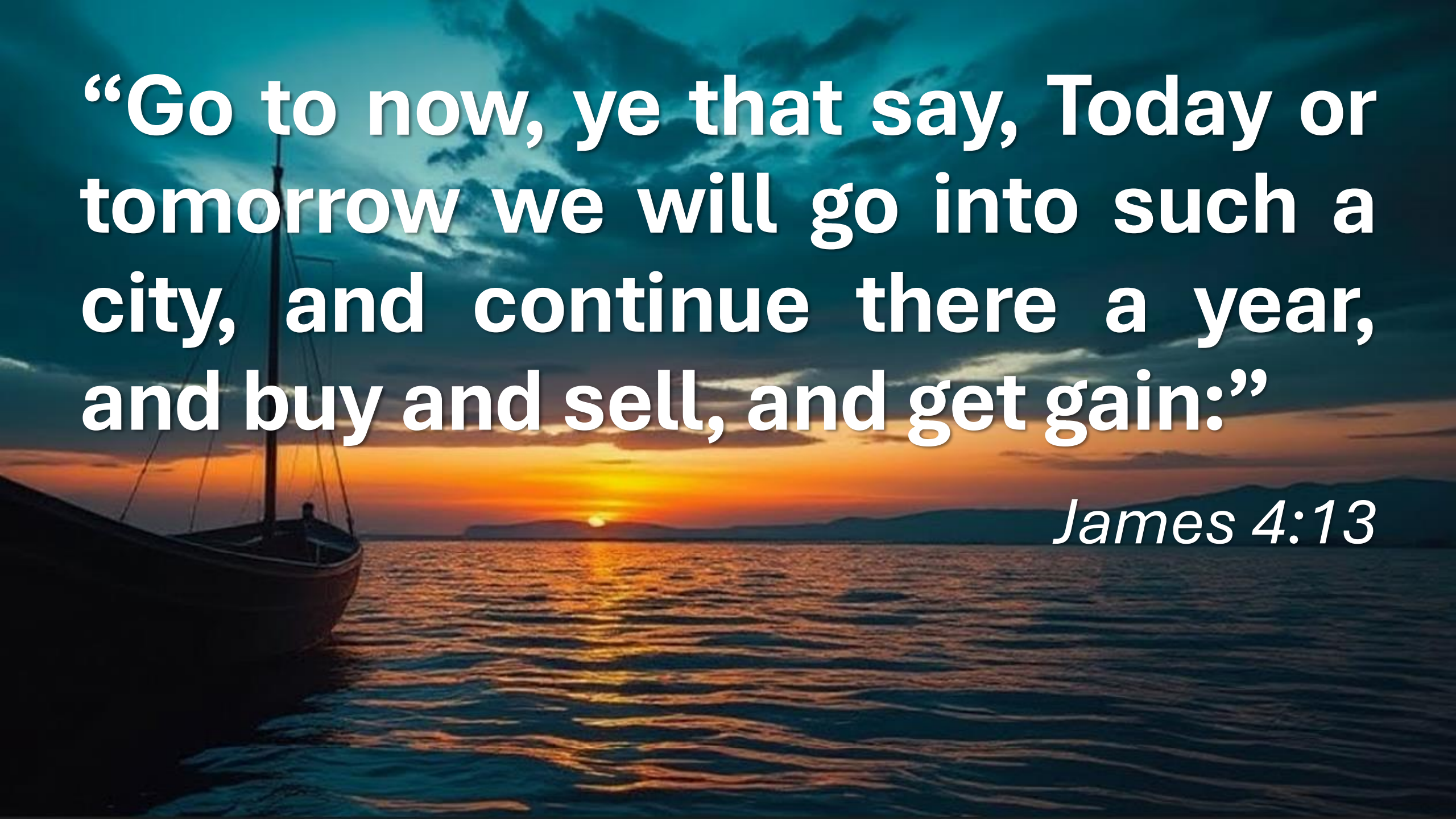
1. If you want to walk by faith, you have to seize your spiritual opportunities.

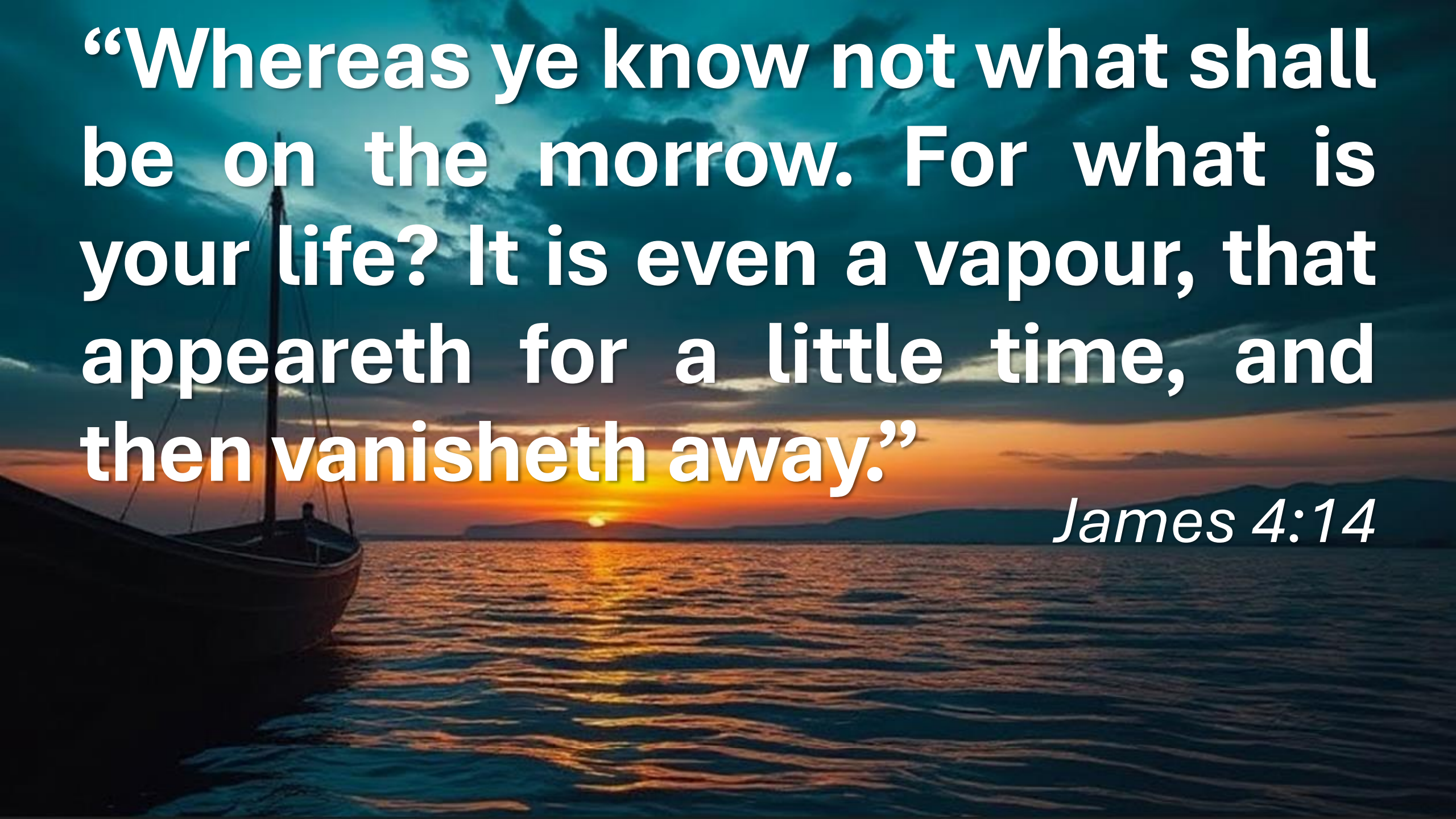
**“Boast not thyself of tomorrow;

Lessons about Faith

4. You have to verbalize your faith (vs. 51).
5. Faith follows after Jesus heals (vs. 52).

You may not see everything clearly yet, but if you'll cry out, step out, and walk it out, Jesus will make sure you end up on the road with Him.
