A Person with INTEGRITY has...

1. A Single Heart

"do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15)

2. A Single Mind

"a double minded man is unstable in all his ways" (James 1:8)

3. A Single Will

"no man can serve two masters" (Mt. 6:24)
