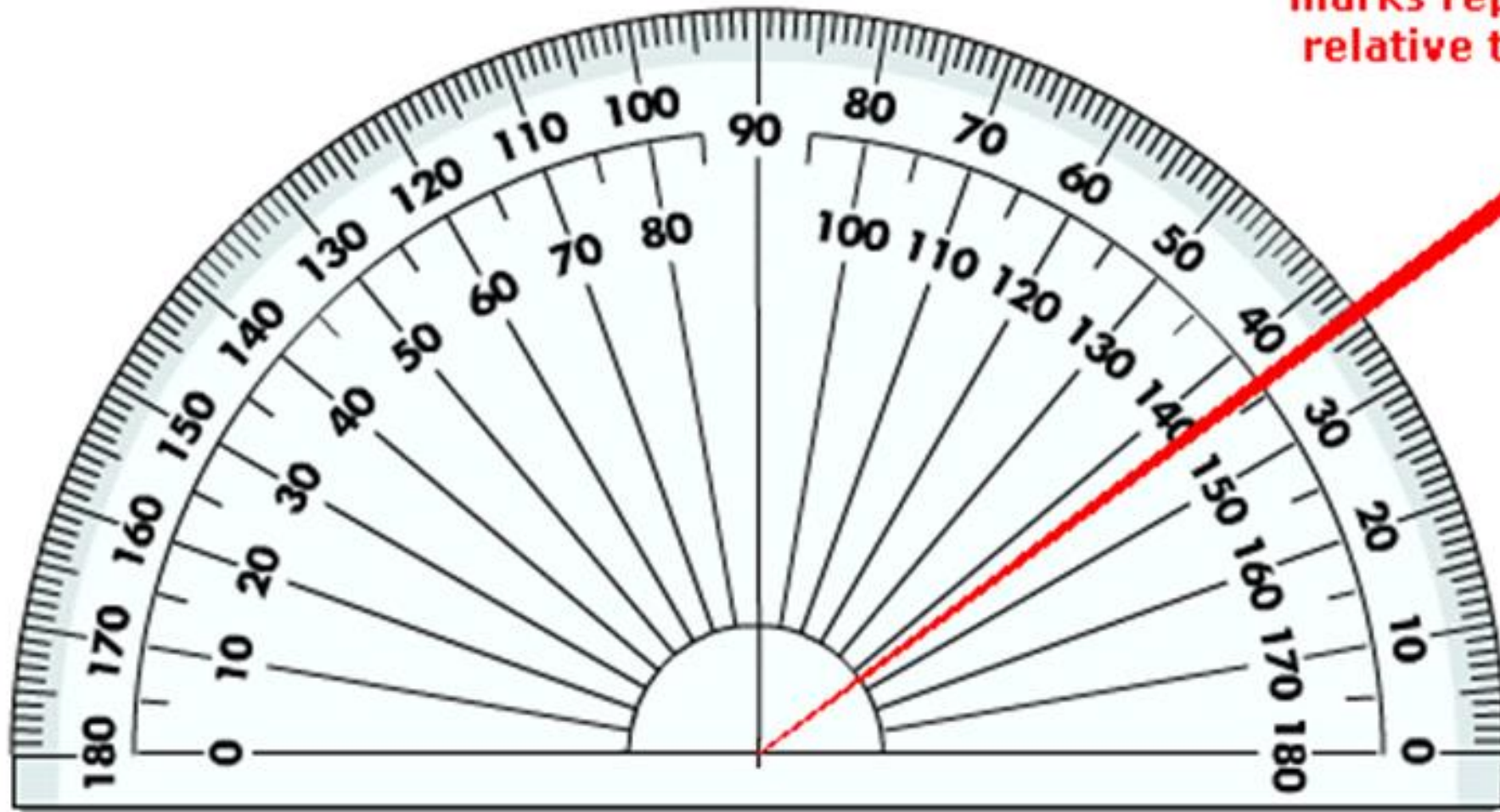

2. We are transformed by looking into and beholding the glory of Jesus, having His glory **SLOWLY** change us into His image *(vs. 18)*.

the glory of the Lord!**

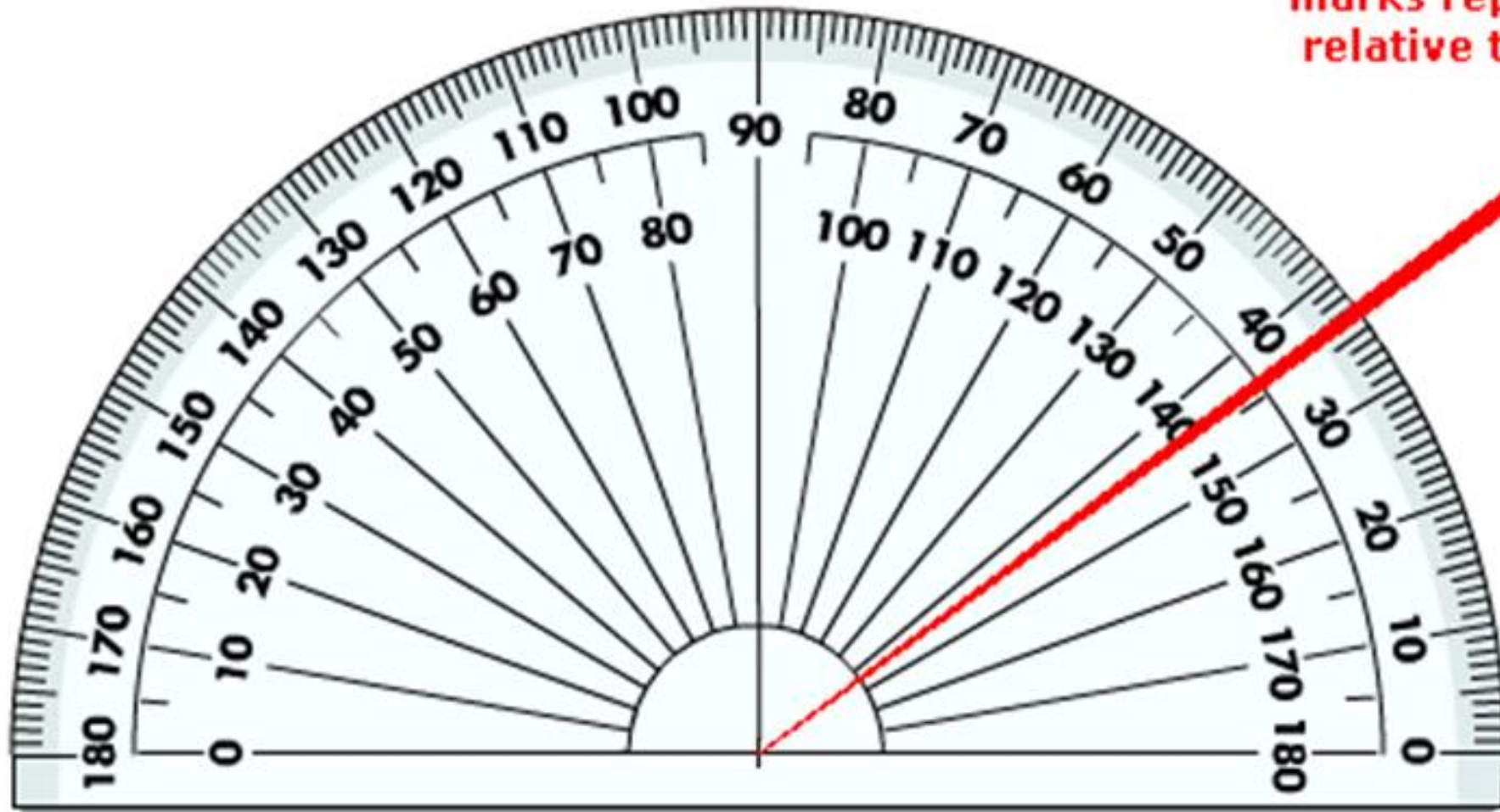


The space between two adjacent marks represents one degree relative to the vertex of any angle.

One degree over the course of a decade will turn you into something you can't even imagine.

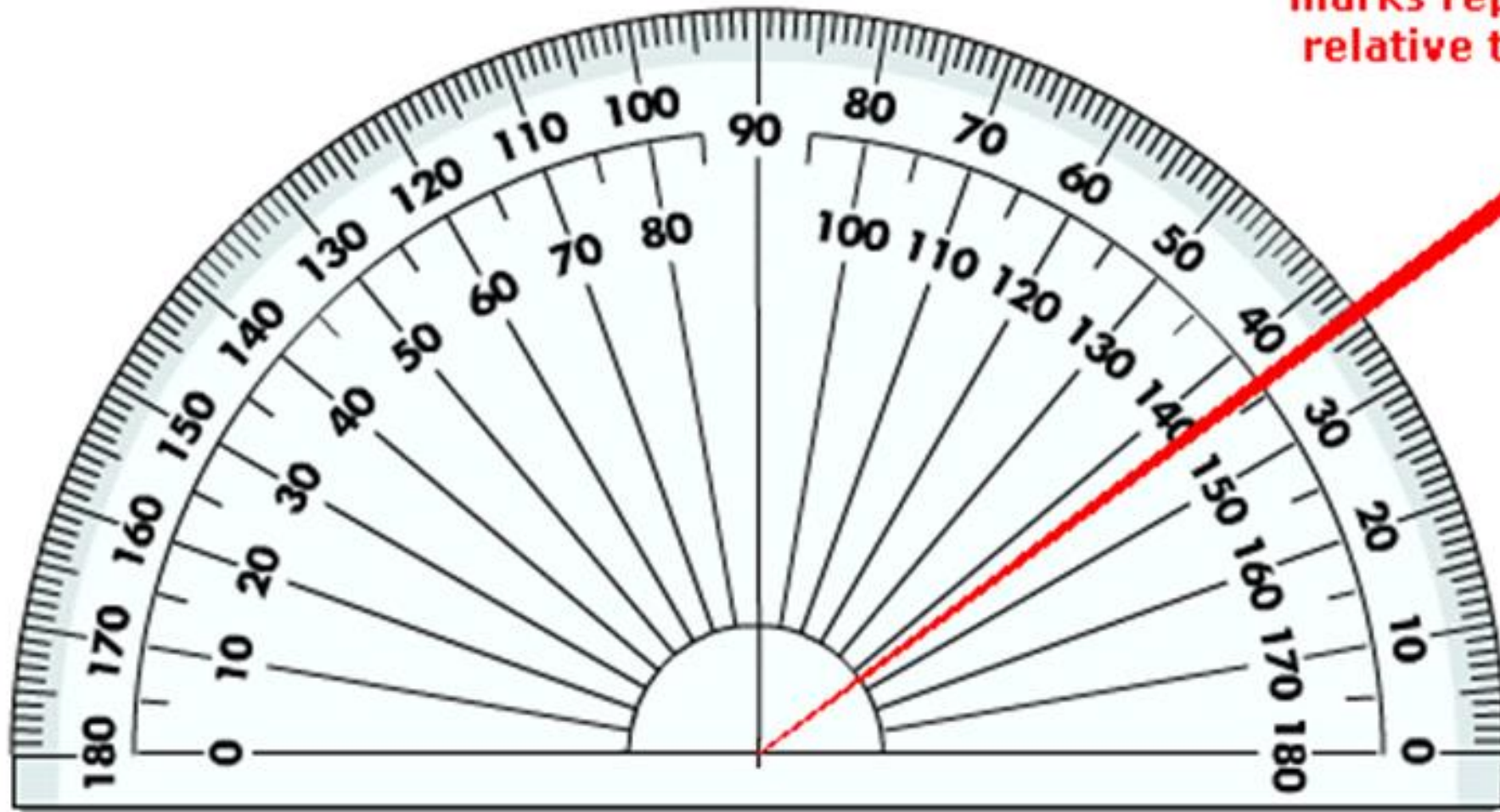






The space between two adjacent marks represents one degree relative to the vertex of any angle.

How are we transformed?

3. Discipleship is deep work, over time, in community.

Next Steps
