




Preparation for the Fire

Daniel 1:11-12, 17, 20; 3:16-18

- These young men operated from the strength of internal principle rather than the intimidation of external pressure in times of crisis and trouble.
- These young men trusted in the sovereign will of God with their life.

Preservation in the Fire

Daniel 3:19-27

- This world's system will not be happy if you do not conform to it.
- God is with us in every trial (vv. 24-25).
- The world intently watches suffering (vv. 24, 26).

Purpose of the Fire

Daniel 3:28-30

- The character and courage of the men was so unusual that a pagan king immediately gave glory to the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.
- There is tremendous spiritual power in being willing to die for what you believe.
