

What is fruit?

- 1) Inner fruit fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22)
- 2) Outward fruit allowing God to work through you to bring Him glory
 - Sharing your faith (Rom. 16:5)
 - Living out your faith (Matt. 5:16)
