## Ezekiel 34:2-6

Shepherds of Israel who have been feeding yourselves *(vs. 2)*.

The weak you have not strengthened *(vs. 4)*.

The sick you have not healed *(vs. 4)*.

The injured you have not bound up *(vs. 4)*.

The stray you have not brought back *(vs. 4)*.

The lost you have not sought *(vs. 4)*.

With force and harshness, you have ruled them *(vs. 4)*.
