


What Does God Actually Want from Me?

Micah 6:6-8



Wherewith shall I come before the LORD, and bow myself before the high God? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves of a year old? (Micah 6:6)

What do I give to God?

Not having multiple sets of values based on the circumstances

Love Kindness


Don't be hard-hearted

Be merciful
