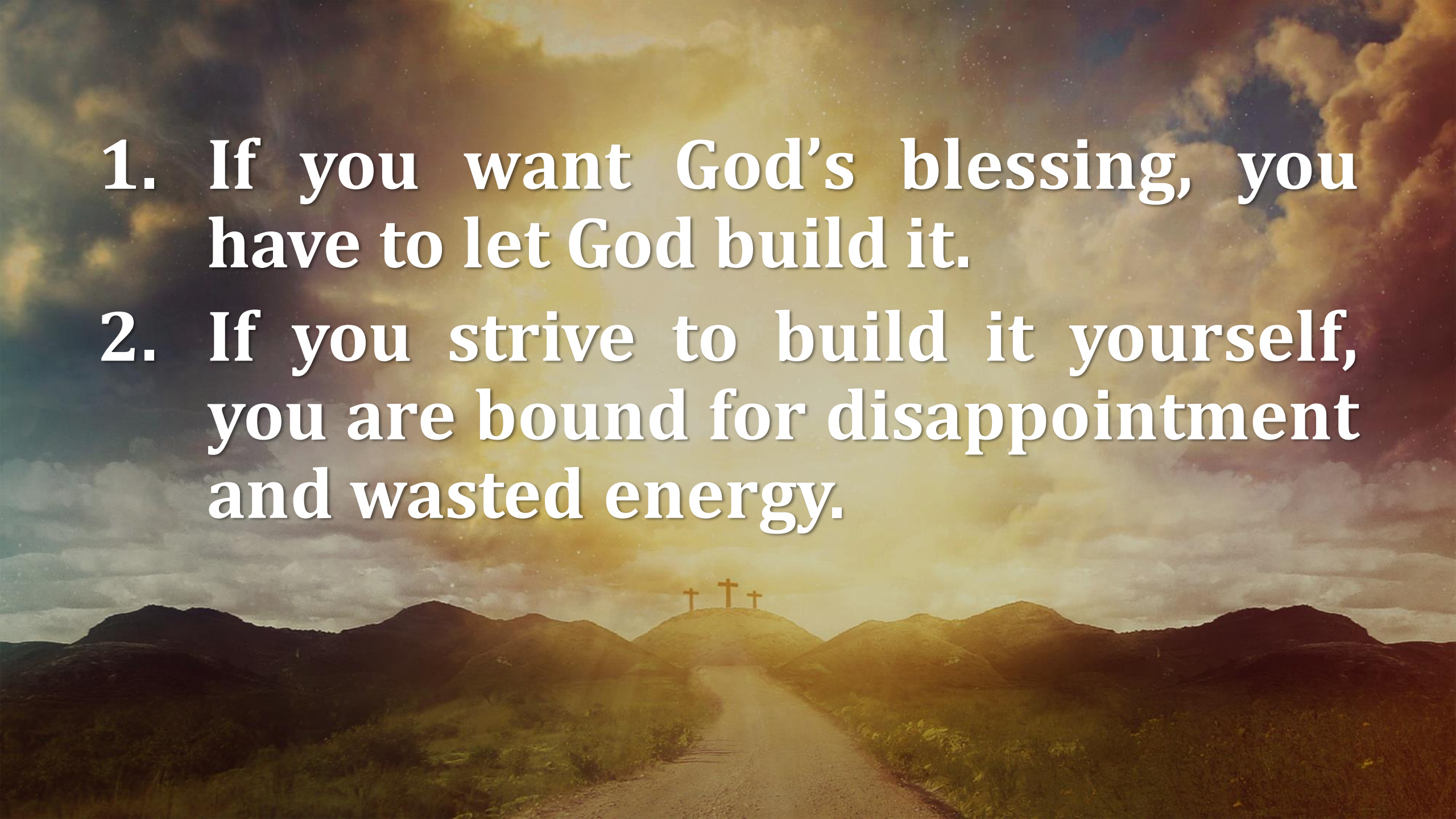

God's plan is far more critical to the outcome than man's efforts.

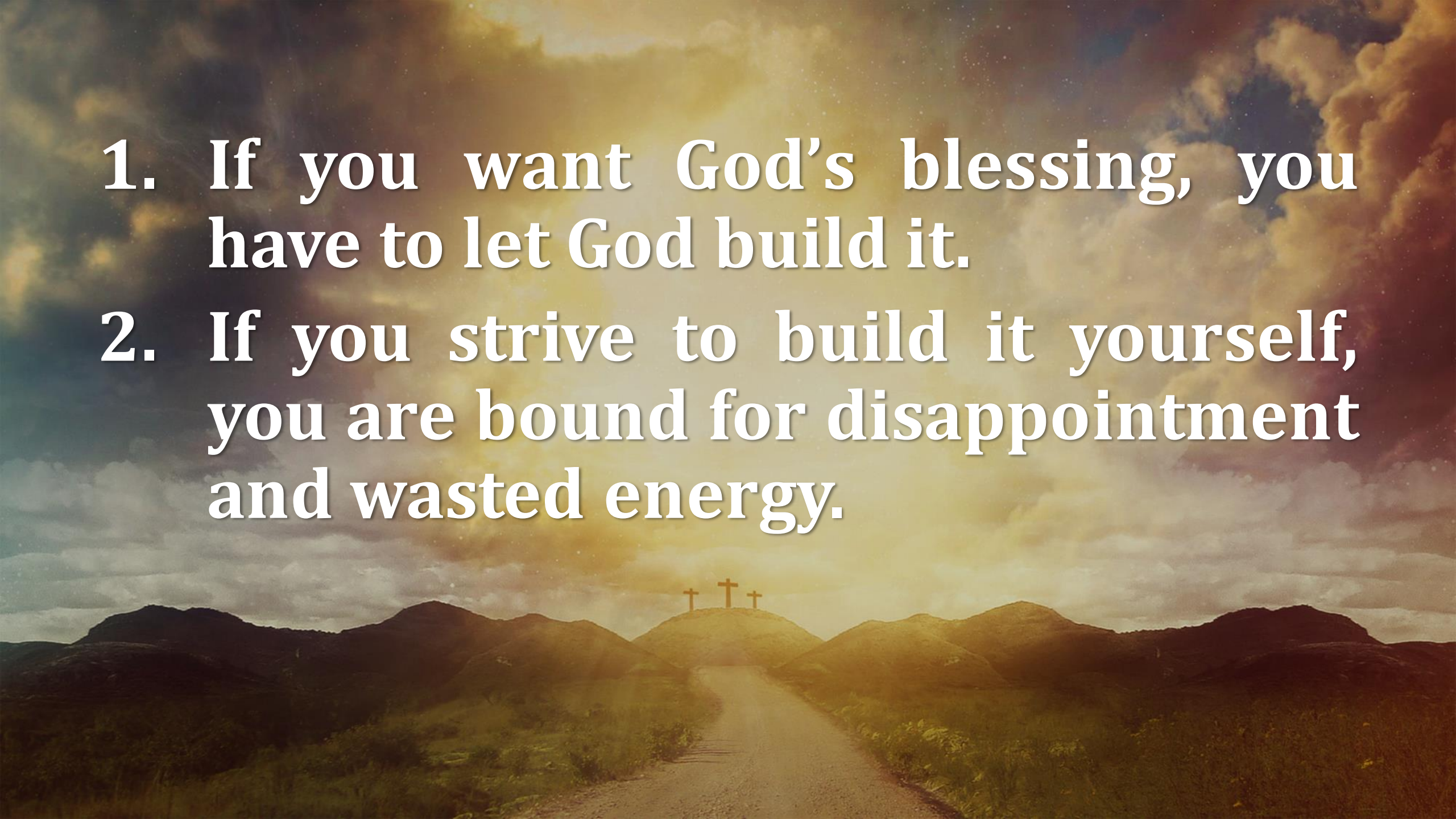
1. If you want God's blessing, you have to let God build it.
