MEMORIALS

"to remember" God doesn't want us to forget because He knows we DO forget!

God's promise of blessing is always attached to steps of faith.

1. Make a habit of establishing memorials at the intersections of God's miraculous hand in your life.

God doesn't want us to forget because He knows we DO forget!

- **1. Tell your story. Keep it clear in your memory what God did for you** (vv. 22-23a).
- 2. Tell the stories of God's faithfulness and activity in the generations that preceded you (vs. 23b).
- **3. Tell these stories because people all over the world need to hear them and be overwhelmed with God's power and greatness in your lives, all throughout history** (vs. 24).
- 4. Keep telling the stories so that you don't trivialize God or your relationship to Him, so that your own sense of awe and wonder and reverence is deepened and strengthened the more you hear them (vs. 24b).
