3 major problems with God

- 1. You don't seem to care
- 2. You aren't doing much when you could
- 3. What you are doing doesn't seem fair



Lessons from Habakkuk's story:

1. Lesson 1: I will never see what God is doing unless I wait



What we do instead of waiting...

- Run
- Press
- Despair
- Fuss

Nobody has ever waited on God and been disappointed. God has never been a minute late.

"what if" or "even if"

"We trade our irrational fears of an uncertain future for the loving assurance of an unchanging God."

 - c. We miss the intimacy



Take Home Truths-

Four key spiritual lessons for when God places us in the waiting room of life:

- 1. Trust God's Timing
 - "But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength . . ." Isaiah 40:31
- 2. Deepen Your Dependence
 - "Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him . . ." Psalm 37:7
- 3. Grow Where You're Planted
 - "Those who are faithful in little will be faithful in much." Luke 16:10
- 4. Expect God's Goodness
 - "The Lord is good to those who wait for him, to the soul who seeks him." Lamentations 3:2
