### Are you shaping your reality of suffering or is suffering shaping your reality?

### The Saint Sifted by Suffering: JOB

### Outline of Job

- 1. Chapters 1 and 2 we see a conversation between God and Satan
- 2. Chapters 3-38 we see conversations between Job and his friends.
- 3. Chapters 39-42 we see a conversation between God and Job.

### Suffering from three perspectives.

- 1. First, from the perspective of man.
- 2. Second, from the perspective of Satan.
- 3. Third, from the perspective of God.

# Man misused suffering by twisting the truth.

### Misuse # 1: God is Holy

Suggested by Eliaphaz.
Job 4:17 "Can a mortal be more righteous than God? Can a man be more pure than his maker?"

### Misuse # 2: God is Just

Suggested by Bildad.
Job 8:3 "Does God subvert judgment? Or does the Almighty pervert justice?

### Misuse # 3: God is all-wise

#### Suggested by Zophar.

Job 11:7 "Can you search our the deep things of God? Can you find out the limits of the Almighty? They are higher than heaven- What can you do?"

# Satan <u>abused</u> suffering by tempting Job.

### The plan of Satan

-What was he trying to do? Tempt Job to curse God.

#### How was he going to do it?

- Take away his protection. 1:10 "Hedge around him"
- Take away his prosperity 1:10 "the work of his hands"
- Take away his possessions. 1:10 "posessions"
- Take away his property. 1:10 "his land"
- Take away his *physical well being*. 2:7

### The power of Satan

Power over people (Job 1:14,15, 17).
Power over elements (1:16).
Power over weather (1:19).
Power over disease (2:7).

### The peril of Satan

Satan has limited knowledge.
Satan has limited power.
Satan has an unlimited ego.

# God used suffering by testing Job.

### How did God use suffering in Jobs life?

3 Reasons for suffering in the book of Job.

First, to show God is doing wonderful things through our sickness that we don't even know about.

42: 3 There fore I have uttered what I did not understand, things too wonderful for me, which I did not know." 3 Reasons for suffering in the book of Job.

Second, to remove confidence in ourselves.

42: 6 "But now my eye sees you. Therefore I abhor myself, and repent in dust and a shes." 3 Reasons for suffering in the book of Job.

Third, to provide an opportunity to minister.

42: 11 "all those who had been his acquaintances before, came to him and <u>ate food</u> with him in his house; and they <u>consoled him</u> and <u>comforted him</u> for all the adversity that the LORD had brought upon him ."

# 5 Scriptural reminders in regards to suffering.

- First, have an attitude of thanks in seasons of health (Phl 4:11,12).
- Second, have an attitude of trust in seasons of sickness (1 Pet 4:18).
- Third, look to Gods promises for comfort (2 Cor 4:16-18)
- Fourth, anticipate God's reward (Lk 6:23; Jm 1:.
- Fifth, lighten the load through prayer (Phil 4:6-8)..

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
