 - Insecure; Puppet King; Rejected Scripture
- Ugly
 - Murderer; Tyrant; Massacre of the Innocents



Journey of the Wise Men

- Estimated distance: 600–900 miles
 - Average travel: 15–25 miles per day
 - Estimated travel time: 4–8 months or longer
 - Explains why Jesus is found in a house
(Matthew 2:11)


