2 Timothy 3:16-4:5

1. We believe that the Bible is EXACTLY what we need and ALL that we need to successfully live the spiritual life in the middle of DIFFICULT/PERILOUS times (3:16-17).

- We don't mean that the Bible tells us everything that we ever need to know about everything we wonder about.
- The Bible provides everything necessary to live the <u>spiritual</u> life.
- The Bible provides all necessary teaching <u>principles</u> but does not always provide specific <u>details</u>.

2. We believe that the Bible is the final AUTHORITY for what we believe and teach and that we will be held ACCOUNTABLE for that standard (3:16; 4:1).

### **Elements of Biblical Preaching**

- Conviction "reprove"
- Warning "rebuke"
- Appeal "exhort"
- Patience "with all longsuffering"

#### Unfortunately, Many will not Listen

- They will bail out <u>THEOLOGICALLY</u> "they will not endure sound doctrine."
- They will seek teachers who will tell them what they <u>WANT</u> to hear "after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears."
- They will abandon <u>TRUTH</u> for the latest religious fads "they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables."
