




What is this?



What has happened so far in the Letter of Galatians?

Paul has made it clear that the Gospel is from and defined by God, and any addition to the Gospel, specifically the Law, removes its benefit.

What has happened so far in the Letter of Galatians?

If you put your trust in your keeping of the Law, you are cursed, but if you put your faith in the work of Christ, you will receive salvation.

You cannot mix the two!

What has happened so far in the Letter of Galatians? Paul also makes it clear to those who have already received salvation that they do not need to depend on the keeping of the Law to earn or maintain favor with God. Legalism

Does that mean I can do anything I want as long as I put my faith in Christ?

License

No!!!

Our freedom from the Law is not meant to lead us to lawless living but rather to holy living through the Spirit's enabling.

Galatians 5:13-26

¹³ For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. 14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. 15 But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

Galatians 5:13-15

16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. 17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. 18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, ²⁰ Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, ²¹ Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5:19-21 ²² But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, ²³ Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
